CITY OF PALATKA CEMETERY RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All corners, coping, monuments and slabs for gravesites shall be marble or granite, and shall be installed no more than 1" above ground level. Due to ground settling, no slab shall be installed less than 30 days after interment. If monuments/stones sink or become unlevel for any reason, the monument supplier should be contacted for resetting. The City of Palatka is not responsible for resetting any gravesite marker. The City of Palatka is not responsible for setting Veteran's monuments/stones.
2. Marble or granite benches are permitted in all City of Palatka cemeteries, to be placed only on the plot, with the exception of benches in Oakhill West Cemetery, which shall be set only in place of a headstone, and/or may be placed on a separately purchased plot.
3. A permit shall be obtained by the monument supplier prior to the setting of any monument/stone, slab, corner, coping or bench. Monument suppliers shall contact the Cemeteries Supervisor at 386-329-0175 to obtain a permit. The Cemetery Supervisor shall clearly mark the allowable area of installation prior to the delivery of markers, etc.
4. All light materials, including but not limited to, stones, gravel, pebbles, mulch, or granite dust, are strictly prohibited for use as gravesite covering.
5. Vaults shall be concrete and/or steel, and may only be delivered and installed in the cemetery during regular business hours (7:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.)
6. All vehicles, including vault and monument trucks, are limited to the roadway only. No vehicle shall be driven over or across gravesites, with the exception of lawn maintenance equipment operated by City of Palatka Cemetery Personnel.
7. All post-interment flowers, ornaments or other decorations shall be placed in the headstone area only. Nothing shall be hung or placed in any tree or shrub in any cemetery.
